## ***"MOST NEEDED LIST"***

- gauze/bandages
- bandaids
- neosporin
- surgical tape
- gloves
- ankle/arm/neck splints that you can find at drug stores
- hydrogen peroxide
- rubbing alcohol
- steri strips (some might know them as butterflies- can be found at most drug stores for pulling together wounds)
- tylenol (adult and children)
- ibuprofen
- antibiotics (if people need individual consultation on antibiotics I can do that on an email basis)
- crutches
- canes
- Duffel bags for carrying medical supplies
