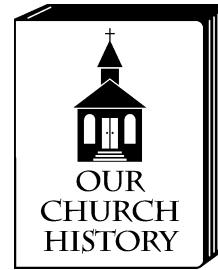
### Church to Provide Snacks for Habitat Workers: March 8 - 12
