

Our Session has designated our 40% to go to the **Chipola Area Autism Resource Center, Inc.** \$304.49 has been received to date, of which 40% will be donated to the Autism Support Group.

Our **Food Pantry Offering** for June will be received next Sunday, June 23. During the month of May our food pantry served 409 families consisting of the following age groups 314 (0-18), 424 (19-59) and 248 (60+) for a total of 986 individuals.

We will be ordering Green bib aprons to be used when we host Presbytery in September and on other occasions like Lenten Luncheons and for other events. 12 aprons will be ordered for use and to remain at the church.
