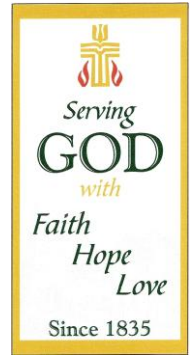

Our **Food Pantry Offering** for June will be received this morning. During the month of May our food pantry served 409 families consisting of the following age groups 314 (0-18), 424 (19-59) and 248 (60+) for a total of 986 individuals.

Thank you to Steve, MaryAnn and Hunter Hutton, Matt Brickler, Freddie Harvey, Pastor Ted Land, Valerie Marlow and Emma Smith for their help with unloading the Second Harvest USDA truck for the Food Pantry. A total of over 9,000 pounds of food commodities were stocked in the pantry, and over 700 pounds of bakery goods were delivered from Walmart and Winn Dixie Marianna Stores.
