SHARING OF THE LIGHT OF CHRIST, OUR EMMANUEL

(The pastor will light a candle from the Christ Candle and light the candles of the elders, who will then light the candles of the first person on each aisle. Light will then be passed from worshiper to worshiper. The lighted candle should remain upright and the unlighted candle is tipped to the lighted candle.)

(the candle is held close to the chest)

- 1. Silent night, holy night! All is calm, all is bright,

(the candle is extended upward)

- 3. Silent night, holy night! Son of God, love's pure light

* THE CHARGE AND BENEDICTION

Leader: Let us look at the light of our candles, and let us remember that in Jesus God has come to us as our Lord Emmanuel.

Unison: Jesus is our assurance that God is with us,

Leader: and that God will never leave or forsake us,

Unison: and that nothing in life or in death can separate us from God's love.

Leader: Let us go forth into the darkness of this night knowing that God is with us.

Unison: Let us go forth into the darkness of every day and every night knowing that God will be with us.

Leader: Let us go forth from this place to share the good news that Jesus has been born.

Unison: Emmanuel has come! God is with us!

*** SHARING GOD'S GIFTS OF CHRISTMAS**

(Please extinguish your candle, and then please take it with you to the receptacles in the narthex or the hallway as you leave. As you leave, please greet those around you, as we share together the good news of Jesus, our Lord Emmanuel, God with us.)
