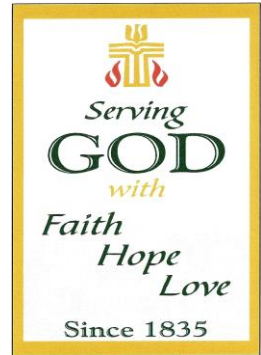

Daylight Savings Time Ends next Sunday, November 1 at 2 a.m. Please remember to turn your clocks back one hour before going to bed on Saturday night.






